- There are currently six sections of kindergarten.
- This allows for smaller classroom sizes and more one-on-one attention.
- There is one classroom that works closely with an ELL teacher. Services are given both in the classroom as well as out of the classroom.
- There is one integrated co-teach classroom within this room a special education teacher and a general education teacher team teach.

Other Services Offered

- When students are screened for kindergarten, they are also screened for occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech services.
- If a child is in need of these services, they will receive them as soon as they begin in the fall.
